 - promote citizen's participation in accountability, inclusivity and transparency in the devolved structures;
 - create an improved awareness and knowledge on the devolved system of government and its possibilities;

- enhance accountability and transparency in the management of devolved government structures; and
- Identify lessons learned which can be used in future planning of interventions in the support of social justice movements
